CAN YOU HELP?

Case #87—Frank found two male kittens by the road last fall and took them in. He also has a three year old Lab mix that he got from a family member who could no longer care for him. He would love to get all three neutered but only receives SSI disability and does not have enough to cover the expense. SNAP's cost to fix these animals is \$195.

Case #88- Michelle is a single mom living on a very low income. She rescued a stray cat and has a young male Boxer mix that needs to be fixed. She cannot keep them unless they are both fixed. SNAP's cost totals \$160.

Case #89- Billie has four dogs, two of which he was able to fix on his own a year ago. The two dogs still needing to be fixed are now adult pups of one of the fixed dogs. He has not been able to save the money to have these Husky mixes neutered due to some unexpected circumstances. It will cost \$215 to have these animals done thru SNAP.
