**Case #117** Sheila is a single parent. She has an older Beagle mix who has had a couple of litters over the last few years. She kept one of the puppies from the first litter and has also had a stray female kitten show up at her door that is breeding age. SNAP's cost to fix them is \$200.

**Case #118** Isaac has a female lab mix a family member could not keep. In addition, he has a young male cat that needs to be neutered. He has been out of work for the past six months and is trying to make ends meet until he is called back to his job. The cost for both animals is \$130.

**Case #119** This family of three has two large dogs they found in bad situations a couple of years ago. Unfortunately, the dogs recently got together and had a litter. They found homes for all but one puppy and need assistance having all three fixed before there is another accident. SNAP's cost is \$270.
