Case #126 Chris has three Pit Bulls needing to be fixed before there is another litter of puppies. They have been in his family for a couple of years, and they have not had the extra funds to get them fixed. Now, in order to keep them, they must have them spayed/neutered. SNAP's cost to fix them is \$300.

Case #127- Joyce had a stray cat show up at her home with a litter of young kittens. She took them in and eventually found homes for the kittens. The female stayed and has had another litter that are now all old enough to reproduce. She could not find homes this time and needs help getting all five cats fixed. The three females and two males will cost \$290.

Case #128- Kim lives in an area where there are a lot of strays. She tries to help the best she can and over the years has gotten what she can fixed. The last couple of years have been challenging and she needs help getting the last three cats and two dogs fixed. SNAP's cost is \$340.
