CAN YOU HELP?

Case # 25 —Christy recently moved here from another state and has two dogs. One came from a bad situation and the other is a stray. Both are females, one is a German Shepherd mix, the other is a Pit Bull mix. The four year old Shepherd has had two litters. Christy lives in Springfield with a family member while she looks for work. Both dogs are large and will cost SNAP \$180 to spay. Christy cannot contribute anything at this time.

Case #26 –Diane lives in Lawrence County and has two strays, a young female cat that just went into heat and a five year old female Husky mix. She has done a good job making sure the dog has never gotten pregnant. She has two other animals that are fixed. She was very appreciative of the assistance and with a monthly income of less than \$1000, she can pay \$20 toward SNAP's cost of \$135.

Case #27 –Mandy has an eight month old female Golden Retriever/Lab mix she got from a bad situation. This is her only pet. With three in the household, they are not on public assistance but money is tight with an income of less than \$1000 per month. They can help with \$15 toward the \$80 cost.

If you are able to help fix any of these animals, please send your donation to SNAP, PO Box 14354, Springfield, MO 65814. No amount is too small. It all adds up to do great things! You can specify which case you would like to contribute to. In the event the case you specify has already been helped by another caring donor, your contribution will be used to help a different but equally in-need pet owner as determined by the SNAP team.
