CAN YOU HELP?

Case # 28 –Tina lives in Greene County. The family of five has a female 2 year old Boxer they took from a bad situation. They also have a 3 year old male cat. They have wanted to fix the animals for a long time but just don't have the extra money. SNAP's cost on both animals will be \$115. Tina is going to try to contribute \$20.

Case #29 –Kayla has taken in 2 homeless cats. Both cats are females, approximately 2 years old, one is a calico and the other is a gray tabby. She also took in a female Pit Bull that a neighbor could no longer keep. The dog is also 2 years old. Kayla has done a great job of not letting any of them get pregnant but she worries about it all the time. The cost to SNAP is \$190, Kayla can pay \$30 of that.

Case #30 –Sondra lives in an area of Springfield where there are many stray cats. She has taken in 4 young adult females that will get bred if not spayed. Her only income is child support for one child. They are also on food stamps and Medicaid. SNAP's cost on the 4 cats is \$220. Sondra offered to send in \$40, but we don't see how she can spare it.

You can specify which case you would like to contribute to. In the event the case you specify has already been helped by another caring donor, your contribution will be used to help a different but equally in-need pet owner as determined by the SNAP team.
