CAN YOU HELP?

Case # 31 —Corina lives in an area where there are several stray and dumped cats. She has found homes for the kittens but has ended up with five adult cats, all females and two dogs, a male boxer mix and a female beagle. She lives alone on disability and can afford to contribute \$40. SNAP's cost for all seven animals is \$275.

Case #32 –Annie is a single parent of one and recently lost her job. She has a cat that she got done several years ago and had rescued a puppy before she lost job. He is now 10 months old weighing in over 50 pounds and needs to be neutered. Annie has no money to contribute; SNAP's cost is \$80.

Case #33 –Sandra has three cats and two dogs all fixed. Two stray cats recently showed up, a male and a female. Sandra had open heart surgery this year and has high medical bills, so doesn't have the extra to have these two new additions fixed. She lives on a very limited income. SNAP's cost is \$90.
