CAN YOU HELP?

Case # 42 —Chris took three kittens this summer that were going to be shot. He is keeping all of them and has a female calico, a female black and white and a male gray and white tabby. They are approximately six months old now. SNAP's cost to get them spayed/neutered will be \$145.00.

Case #43-Erica lives in north Springfield in an area where there are a large number of strays. She has taken a female Pit Bull that was abandoned at a house, has rescued two male Chihuahua mixes from a bad situation and given a home to a stray cat with two female kittens. The cost to fix all these animals is \$365.00.

Case #44-Cindy has adopted three stray cats, a female calico, and a kitten from her last litter and an older male. The calico has had three litters that Cindy knows about. She also has a large female black lab mix that her brother left with her. Prudence has had two litters. Currently, this family of six has no steady income. They would greatly appreciate being able to fix these animals. The cost will be \$245.00.

If you are able to help fix any of these animals, please send your donation to SNAP, PO Box 14354, Springfield, MO 65814. No amount is too small. It all adds up to do great things! You can specify which case you would like to contribute to. In the event the case you specify has already been helped by another caring donor, your contribution will be used to help a different but equally in-need pet owner as determined by the SNAP team.
