CAN YOU HELP?

Case # 45 —Todd recently moved to the Springfield area with four animals he got as strays several years ago. The three female cats are all from the same litter and there is one female black and white lab mix. All the animals are now between four and five years old. He has done a great job of not having any litters but now really needs to get them spayed. He is on Medicaid and food stamps. SNAP's cost to get them done is \$55 per cat and \$80 for the dog.

Case #46-Hanna is in a similar situation as Todd with three cats and one dog needing to be fixed. She took in two stray male cats and got a female cat and male dog from family members who could no longer care for the animals. These animals are all about a year old. SNAP's cost is \$35 for the male cats, \$55 for the female cat and \$80 for the male Australian Shepherd mix.

Case #47-Chelsea has three animals she took from bad situations. She has a female cat, a male Beagle mix and a female Pit Bull mix. All the animals are close to a year in age. She is working two jobs to try to make ends meet but can't set enough money aside to fix the animals. SNAP's cost for the cat is \$55, the smaller dog is \$60 and the large dog is \$80.
