CAN YOU HELP?

Case # 57 —Debbie just moved to Springfield from Tennessee and ended up taking in two unwanted dogs. One is a female ShihTzu/Beagle mix and one is a male Golden Retriever mix. She is currently living with a family member and has no income. SNAP's cost to get them done is \$120.00

Case #58-Justin has a mess. He had a stray cat show up that had kittens. Three years later, he has seven adult females that still need to be spayed. The three male cats he has he neutered on his own. He is going thru a tough time and cannot afford to fix the females. The cost to fix all of the cats is \$385.

Case #59-Kari and her husband have three children. They took in a stray pregnant dog and were able to place all but three of the puppies who are now almost five months old. At this point, they are planning to keep the pups and their mother. These Australian Shepherd mix dogs, two females and two males will cost \$240 to be fixed.

You can specify which case you would like to contribute to.
