What is AmazonSmile?

CAN YOU HELP?

Case # 63 –Joyce took in two dogs from a friend who could no longer care for them. One is an eighty pound Shepherd/Husky mix and the other is a Terrier mix of some kind, both males. She is a single mom, on food stamps and Medicaid. SNAP's cost to get them done is \$160.00.

Case #64-Joanna found a litter of five kittens in the woods this spring. They appeared to have been dumped so she took them home. The kittens are now four months old and need to be fixed. She is planning to keep them since good homes are hard to find. There are two females and three males. The cost to fix all five of the cats is \$215.00

Case #65-Tabitha had a neighbor move away and leave their animals behind. Three female cats, one with a litter of four, one male cat and a female lab/heeler mix. She is going to place the kittens but will keep the adults. The cost to fix the four cats and the dog is \$280.

If you are able to help fix any of these animals, please send your donation to SNAP, PO Box 14354, Springfield, MO 65814. No amount is too small. It all adds up to do great things! You can specify which case you would like to contribute to. In the event the case you specify has already been helped by another caring donor, your contribution will be used to help a different but equally in-need pet owner. Thank you for your support!
