CAN YOU HELP?

Case #84 –Sarah moved to the Springfield area a few months ago looking for work. She is on public assistance at this time. She found two stray dogs, an Australian Shepherd mix and a Lab mix, both males and needs to have them neutered. SNAP's cost to fix these dogs is \$160.

Case #85- Jordan lives in Springfield and recently lost her job. She took in a stray cat that has had a couple of litters and two stray dogs, a Shepherd mix and a Beagle mix, both females. She placed all the kittens except one male and needs everyone fixed. SNAP's cost to get all four animals done totals \$250.

Case #86- Carissa had a Pit Bull mix and her puppy given to her. She is a single mom and the dogs have been great with her kids. She hasn't been able to afford to have the dogs fixed and wants to get it done as soon as possible especially with the Pit Bull ban in Springfield being such a hot topic. (The ban was passed in September but is now on hold since a petition was turned in and needs to be reviewed) The dogs will cost \$180 thru SNAP.

If you are able to help fix any of these animals, please send your donation to SNAP, PO Box 14354, Springfield, MO 65814. No amount is too small. It all adds up to do great things! You can specify which case you would like to contribute to. In the event the case you specify has already been helped by another caring donor, your contribution will be used to help a different but equally in-need pet owner. Thank you for your support!
